

Craigielaw Update 17th July 2020

Please note the following changes and additions to the Craigielaw Operation.

Temporary Lounge

As of the 18th July we will open up the entrance foyer as a temporary lounge, this is in addition to the outside seating beside the pro shop. Hot and cold drinks can be purchased from the pro shop and I would remind all members to maintain social distancing of 2m in both areas.

The main lounges suffered from extensive leaks during the shutdown of the building work, gladly you will have noticed the building work has resumed and contractors are in the process of repairing the damage. When the areas are repaired and deep cleaned/sanitised we will communicate the opening date.

Short Game Area/Putting Green

These facilities will open from Saturday 18th July, please use your own practice balls on both areas and maintain social distancing at all times. Please note there will be no holes cut in the putting green for the time being.

Revised Fixture List

After meeting with the Members Liaison Committee on Monday we have agreed a revised fixture list for the remainder of the season on the run up to the change over to the World Handicapping System in November. I would note that all of the medal dates below will run as optional medal days, meaning you can book a time as normal and opt in to play in the event or decide just to play a normal round. I would also note that supplementary cards are also now allowed although all current handicaps this year will not lapse as we move over to the WHS so those members with no scores in their file will maintain their handicap this year. If submitting a supplementary card I would draw your attention to submitting a score in the rules below.

Competition Rules

- Scoring/Submitting Cards - Scores will be recorded by one member of the group, at the completion of play he/she will verbally agree each players hole-by-hole score. Once this has been done he/she will take a clear picture of the 3 scores on the scorecard and email the picture to info@craigielawgolfclub.com before the leaving the club. PLEASE NOTE: All players names must be clearly marked on the scorecard. We do not require the card to be submitted in any other method.
- Flagsticks - shall remain in the hole at all times. The ball will only be considered holed when any part of the ball comes to rest below the surface of the putting green.
- Bunkers – If a player’s ball comes to rest in a bunker, the player will proceed as follows:
Modified Local Rule E-3: When a player's ball lies in a bunker in a footprint or divot mark, the player may take free relief once by placing the ball 6 inches, not nearer the hole from the spot of the original ball and with no smoothing of the area before placing.
- Traffic Management Stakes & Rope – These are to be treated as “Immovable Obstructions”, free relief from interference by an immovable obstruction may be taken under Rule 16.1 (1 club length from the nearest point of relief not closer to the hole). The player has extra options if the obstruction is close to the putting green and on the line of play which are outlined on the score card.

Please do not touch any of the stakes.
