Members Guests

From this weekend Members guests will now be allowed.

Pro Shop

The pro shop will open from the 3rd July.

There will be a strict maximum of 3 customers in the shop at any one time and we ask that everyone adheres to social distancing guidelines when inside the shop.

The team will have a protective screen at the counter, we ask that everyone conducts their transactions at this section of the counter.

To register for a booking please continue to use the pro shop window.

Outside seating and drinks area

On Friday the 3rd July the area beside the pro shop window will have seating added and tea, coffee and a selection of soft drinks and beers will be available from the pro shop window. Whilst this will give members a chance to enjoy a drink after their round we would remind players of the need to socially distance in this area.

Driving Range

The Driving range will also be open for use on the 3rd July.

The range will be limited to 1 pre-round warm-up token per player.

The range is only open for players with a tee time on either South Links or Championship course, no practice sessions allowed.

On completion of your warm-up we ask that all baskets be returned to the sanitizing station beside the ball dispenser.

All tokens will be sanitized.

Opening times are between 0800-1800 Mon-Fri, 0730-1700 Sat/Sun.

Indoor bays will remain closed.

There will be a reduced number of hitting bays available, we ask that play is only from these designated bays and to not congregate on the driving range. Please also do not enter the range to pick up balls.

Lessons will be available from Friday 3rd July

The professional staff will be available to offer lessons on a restricted schedule. During tuition, social distancing will be maintained and will only be conducted on the outdoor grass bays. For more information and bookings please call 01875 870800.

I would remind all members to cancel any time that they do not intend using and members booked to play after pro shop hours must sign the tee sheet on the pro shop window and to also register and pay in advance for any guests that may be playing with you.

Course
