I am pleased to say the online booking system has handled the demand for times apart from one issue on Monday morning, please note despite the pro shop opening today for calls the online system is still the best way to book tee times on the main course. If you wish to book the South Links you can do this 24 hours in advance by calling the shop 01875 870800. A reminder you must have a tee time to visit the club please do not come down if you have not secured a time on either course.

Every available tee time for every available day has now been booked on the main course, assuming we see things running smoothly over the weekend we will release more tee times both earlier than 9am and later than the 5:30pm these times can be booked online from Monday 1st at 8am for the whole week. I will remind members if you are not going to use your tee time you must cancel, also there is a one member one tee time per day policy any duplicates will be cancelled and if repeated the ability for that member to book will be removed.

Please note with the tee sheet as full as it is the Car Park will at times be very busy I must remind you to keep up social distancing, the other pressure with so much golf is course condition, repair pitchmarks, replace divots and smooth out the bunkers with feet and/or club.

I hope you enjoy your golf when you do play, please adhere to the measures in place and let's hope that we can all return to a more normal operation sometime soon.
